Message from the Parish Priest

Further Relaxation of Restrictions During the Covid-19 Pandemic

The Archbishop has released his <u>Seventh Pastoral</u> Letter to the Clergy and Faithful of the Archdiocese of <u>Sydney with Special Directives for Churches and Liturgies</u> following the further relaxation of restrictions during the COVID-19 pandemic. Among the directives of the letter is that the Parish must continue to keep a record of those who are entering the church for Mass and address the four square metre rule in the church. Thus, the seating capacity for our church is 120 people. In order to facilitate a larger number of registrations of parishioners for each Mass, Father Michael has instructed the Parish Office to manage Mass bookings online via Eventbrite commencing on Monday 6 July 2020.

Parishioners who do not have access to the online booking platform can contact the Parish Office upon which the Parish Secretary will register them on their behalf.

Message from the Parish Priest (Continued)

Bookings must be submitted 48 hours prior to each Mass. For any parishioners arriving at the church for Mass without having first registered, we encourage you to arrive early and we will be pleased to record your details and invite you into the church, provided that the maximum church capacity (under the current Federal Government ruling) has not been reached.

The capacity of the Parish's facilities are as follows:

Church: 120 people.

Harrington Hall: 36 people.

Mother Mary Room: 10 people.

Fr Terry Bell Room: 12 people.

In his Pastoral Letter, the Archbishop states: "As the 4m2 rule and prudential concerns will continue to prevent many of the faithful attending, all but priests continue for the time being to be dispensed from the obligation of attending Sunday Mass; but those who are at low risk of infection and able to do so are exhorted to take all reasonable steps to attend Sunday Mass. The faithful who cannot attend Mass should keep Sunday holy by setting aside some time for prayer at home, reading the Scriptures of the day, or watching Mass on television or online, asking God for the graces they would normally receive in Holy Communion ('spiritual communion'). They might attend Mass on a weekday where possible. Churches should, where possible, be open during the week for private prayer, especially for those unable to attend Sunday Mass; but, again, this must be scheduled and supervised."

With the Archbishop's latest pastoral letter, restrictions have once again eased. Our Lady of the Rosary will be able to allow up to 120 people inside the Church for worship. All bookings for Masses, until further notice, will be via Eventbrite, an online booking system. To book online, simply go to Our Lady of the Rosary Website olrfairfield.org.au, the image below is what you will see. Click on the url in the section New Mass Registration System and follow the prompts. You may book for up to 10 people but you will need to enter each person's details separately. To book online you must book 48hrs in advance. The Parish Office can also take bookings during office hours up until 3pm every Friday.
