THE EIGHT BEATTUDES.

In the Gospel today, we hear how Jesus went up the mountain. He sat down and His disciples gathered around Him. Then He began to speak. And this is the teaching He gave them. The Beatitudes are the ways which help us to follow Jesus and how to live and live Holy lives. They tells us what our attitudes should be like. Jesus promised in the Beatitudes that our heavenly Father would reward us in heaven if we live according to His teaching in the Gospel.

HAPPY are the poor in spirit: Theirs is the kingdom of Heaven.

Depending on God, not on ourselves. To do God's will not our own.

HAPPY the gentle: They shall inherit the earth: To stand up for what is right not fighting back. To be humble, patient and kind.

HAPPY are they that mourn: they shall be consoled. To be truly sad and sorry for our sins. When we are sad about something we pray to Jesus, because He will help us. He is our dearest friend and He will make us happy.

HAPPY those who hunger for what is right: they shall be satisfied.

To be right with God. To be good and please God. To pray always and be Holy.

HAPPY the merciful: they shall have mercy shown them.

To be kind and merciful to others . If we want God to forgive our sins, we must forgive others.

HAPPY the pure in heart: they shall see God. To keep away from sin, so that we can stay close to Jesus, pray often to Him.

HAPPY the peacemakers: they shall be called sons of God. To be at peace with God, with ourselves, and with people around us.

HAPPY those who are persecuted in the cause of right: Theirs is the kingdom of heaven. To put God first in our lives, and to have courage and not be afraid because God is always with us.
