Today in the first Gospel reading, we are reminded how Jesus entered Jerusalem riding on a donkey. The townspeople welcomed Jesus into Jerusalem. They treated Him like a King. They laid clothes and palm leaves in front of Him as a sign of homage.

They waved palm branches and they shouted "PRAISE GOD!

GOD BLESS HIM WHO COMES IN THE NAME OF THE LORD!

PRAISE GOD.! 'HOSANNA'

Jesus rode on a donkey which is meek, instead of a horse is very symbolic, He shows that He is no earthly king. He comes as the king of peace not riding on a horse of war.

When we bless Jesus we feel blessed and humbled that one so great could love so much. Praise prayer brings us closer to Jesus.

Gospel reflection: Second Gospel reading.

Today's Gospel reading comes from the New Testament book Of Mark. [15: 1-39.]

It is called the passion. It is a long reading.

It is the Gospel of what happened to Jesus. It is a sad story. It helps us if we listen to understand all that Jesus suffered for us because He love us and so that we could be free from our sins.
