Today we celebrate the feast of the 'The Assumption' it a special day in the church year. Because Mary was very special, she was chosen by God to be the mother of His son, Jesus. After her earthly life, God took Mary, body and soul into Heaven to be with Jesus in heaven. This is what 'Assumption' means.

GOSPEL; LUKE: 1: 39-56. THEME: JOY AND THANKFULNESS.

GOSPEL REFLECTION:

What did you hear in today's Gospel?

Allow your children to respond in their own words to hearing the word of God.

Questions to stimulate ideas:

- 1. How do you think Mary felt when she had to travel all the way to the hill countries of Judea to visit her cousin Elizabeth?
- 2. Why did Mary go to visit her cousin Elizabeth?
- 3. What was Elizabeth filled with when she heard Mary's greeting?
- 4. What words did Elizabeth say.
- 5. In what prayer we find these words?
- 6. What was the promise made her by the Lord, that Mary believed would be fulfilled?

In today's Gospel we hear when Mary the soon-mother to be of Jesus sings a song with her cousin Elizabeth about what God is going to do. That song is called the 'Magnificat'. And the words in that song are basically saying, how Mary rejoices in God her saviour and all generations will call her Blessed, for God has done great things for her, and Holy is His name. His mercy is for those who fear Him from generation to generation. That God wants us to do opposite of the hurtful things that some people experience in this world. For instance, the song says that God wants the hungry to be filled up and wants the weak to be strengthened and wants those who are hurt to know God's mercy and healing. We too can live God's way, a way that is opposite of hurting others and to live to love others.

Mary's song known as the 'Magnificat' points us towards the greatness of God. Nothing is impossible for God.

This week think about on some things God has done for you, and give thanks to Him.


THE HAIL MARY:
