
Many of His disciples left Him and stopped going with Him, but some stayed with Him because they knew that the teaching Jesus was teaching was the best thing to learn.

PRAYER. Dear Jesus, help me to make the right choices in life so I can always be a true follower of yours. I ask this in Jesus's name. Amen.




